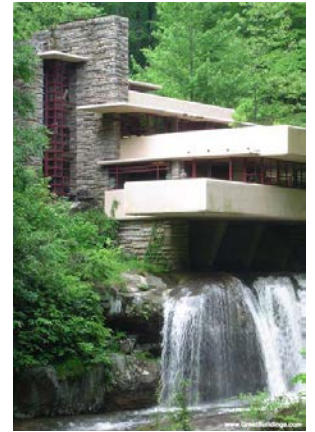

# SAVE AMERICA'S TREASURES AWARDS 1999-2010

From 1999 through 2010, Save America's Treasures (SAT) competitive awards and its congressionally designated grants have helped fix the most prevalent threats to the United States' historic and cultural legacy, which encompasses the diversity of the national experience. Save America's Treasures is unique in its holistic approach to preservation, addressing the needs of this country's most significant historic structures and places, as well as its cultural achievements embodied in books, documents, paintings, film, music and the like. Save America's Treasures represents the best of the distinctively American interdependent system of cultural support, drawing on the expertise and resources of several federal agencies and the leadership of a private sector partner. Federal funding is awarded through congressional designations or earmarks and competitive awards, which use a rigorous process and the benchmark standards of the National Historic Landmarks (NHL) program to evaluate and address the threats to our nation's most significant treasures.

Through its competitive and congressionally designated grants Save America's Treasures has awarded almost \$318 million, which has been matched by more than \$400 million in funds from states, localities, corporations, foundations and individuals. Save America's Treasures is one of the largest and most successful grant programs for the protection of our nation's endangered and irreplaceable cultural heritage. Some 331 National Historic Landmarks have received Save America's Treasures funding. These grants were critical in restoring the exceptional places and structures designated as NHLs such as Boston's Old North Church, Valley Forge and Nevada's Virginia City.

However, these NHLs represent only a fraction of the breadth and scale of the nation's cultural and historic legacy held in trust for all Americans. The following grant tables highlight how SAT's relatively small investment has galvanized public and private efforts in every state in keeping this legacy alive. Every one of the grants in these tables represents the efforts of hundreds of communities and thousands of individuals. Save America's Treasures grants and their prestige has empowered these individuals and communities to rescue, restore and save these irreplaceable resources, which illustrate, interpret and embody the great events, ideas and individuals that contributed to this nation's democratic ideals and achievements.
